The attachments provide projected school site entitlements for Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA), Title I and the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF).

Schools that have fifty percent (50%) or more Free/Reduced Priced Lunch (F/R) students qualify for Titl I funds. Final Title I revenues are not known until the following December and adjustments will be made as needed at that time. As in previous years, one percent (1%) must be used for parent involvement activities.

Title I allocations are based on 202BEDS Enrollment and F/R eligibility (Ages 157 only). These funds must be spent based on the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) and the School Plan for Student Achievement (SPSA), which must align with the district's plan.

LCFF –Low Income (Resource 0007) and LCFF – English Learners (Resource 0009) funds will be used to advance our Equity, Access and Social Justice Guiding Principle as we continue integrating the CA Dashboard, Performance and Targeted Action Index (PTAt)gawith the LCAP, SPSA and budget planning.

Please Note: Sites are expected to spend their current allocation on their current students. If there are unspent school site Title I funds at the end the 20224, maximum of 10% may be carried over to the following year.
