We recently became aware of a video that was posted yesterday, April 17, 2021, on SEIU's Facebook page. The video contains images of District students with an individual dressed in the school's dragon mascot costume. The images used in the SEIU video were posted on the Phoebe Hearst Elementary School webpage in celebration of the reopening of the school. The SEIU video also shows images of the school's logo and the school's marquee.

The video claims that the District's school reopening was "botched" and "now COVID cases are on the rise" because of "bad planning" by the District and "poor social distancing." The video then attempts to tie the COVID cases at several District schools f." The viPc

Let me be clear, our schools reopening plan follows all state and local guidelines and requirements for keeping our students and employees safe.
